



Sermon Notes

SERMON TITLE: “Our Help Comes From the Lord”

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 121:1–3

POINT #1. EXPECTATION = The psalmist looks upward with expectation that help will come from God.

POINT #2 EMPOWERMENT = Our empowerment comes from the Creator Himself, not from human resources.

POINT #3 ENDURANCE = God gives us endurance by keeping us steady and secure
