



After receiving a life-saving liver transplant in 2013, she turned her story into one of triumph and purpose, competing on the world stage as part of Team USA. At the World Transplant Games in Dresden, Matthews earned four gold medals in the 3K power walk, shot put, ball throw, and long jump, and a silver medal in discus. Sermon Notes

SERMON TITLE: “BORN TO WORSHIP”

SCRIPTURE: Isaiah 43:5-7

POINT #1 FEARLESS FAITH—”Fear Not” — God calls His people to trust, not tremble. When God is with you, fear loses its grip.

POINT #2 FAMILY FOCUS. “My sons...my daughters... “God’s gathering is personal and relational. Every believer is family — valued, seen, and called by name.

POINT #3 FAVORED IDENTITY—“Called by My Name” — We belong to God; His name marks us. Our identity is not in what we do but in Whose we are.
