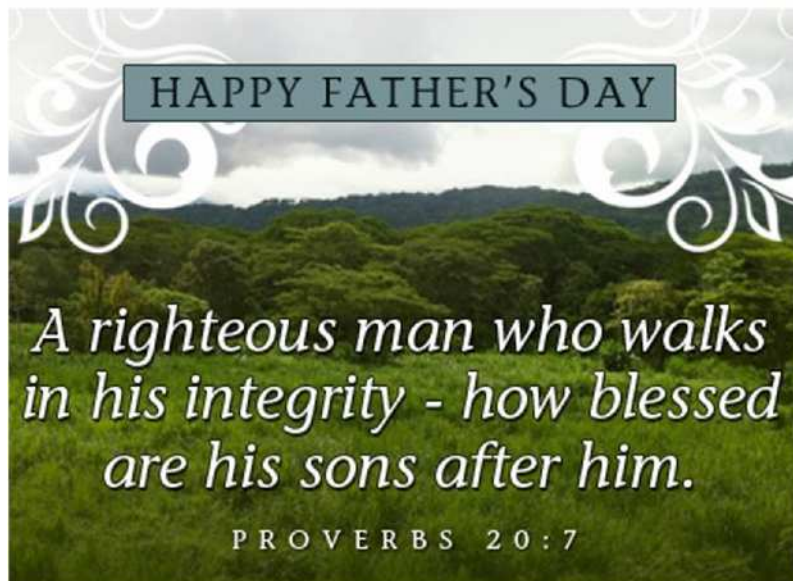

SERMON TITLE: NO MORE EXCUSES
