



Sermon Notes

SERMON TITLE: “Unmute Yourself!”

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 100: 1–3

POINT #1. You don’t need a perfect voice; you just need a joyful one.

POINT #2 When we serve God with joy, people see what real fellowship looks like.

POINT #3 . When you know who made you, you stop trying to be what the world wants.
